Coffee stops now sorted: Ride leader info - there was some discussion about what should and should not be made clear to ride leaders and with reference to what is on the document page of the website. Some amendments were made re potential hazards being mentioned and risk assessed. Is there a more up-to-date CUK sheet about riding with a group. Mention that ride leaders may do a self assessment course on ride leading via the CUK website. Talk of running a month of 'committee rides' where potential ride leaders have the opportunity to plan and lead but where at least one cttee member would be available to help/advise. Discussion followed about access to gpx route files via Garmin Connect.
