- 3 Comment was made about the *communication between CUK and the Group* and the continuing difficulty with finding definitive information. Further details will be sought over the summer and a motion put to the club to investigate this possibility prior to the AGM with voting in October at the AGM. One disadvantage may be the access to CUK members in our postcode area to advertise events.
- 4 Alison mentioned the approach from 'Connie' at the *C&W Herald* to do an article in the supplement. We have already had mention re the Challenge Rides. Fo info the Club was founded as an offshoot of the Lancaster group in 1996 and has since become a separate Eden valley Cumbria Group. Alison has posted a request for any members to say if they are not happy with any photos on blog or website being shared with Connie for the article.
- 3 Runs list: there was some discussion about the impression that a blank runs list gives but that despite that many members were both leading and going out on rides be it at the last moment. Could we perhaps give a link to past months as a saved pdf file? (MB?) to show recent activity?
